Les Éleveurs de dindon du Canada (ÉDC), fondé en 1974, administre le système de mise en marché ordonnée du dindon au Canada. L'objectif principal des ÉDC est d'offrir une stabilité des prix et de l'offre en déterminant la production en fonction des besoins du marché. L'Office représente 513 producteurs de dindon de huit provinces, et en plus d'analyser le marché, il s'occupe activement des domaines suivants : recherche, commercialisation, salubrité des aliments, élaboration de politiques, commerce et analyse de la réglementation. 






